CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That . A. L. ESPI.

of Island Route, Sunny Valley, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Brimstone Creek a tributary of Graves Creek, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of fire protection and domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ acre garden under Permit No. 16421 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 16, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for fire protection,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, Township 34 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a stake 430 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 34 South of Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence North about 132 feet to where said line intersects the Southerly line of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company's Right of Way; thence northwesterly along said Right of Way about 180 feet to where the county road crosses the said Southern Pacific Railroad Company's Right of Way; thence in a southerly direction along said County Road to the place of beginning, containing in all about 7/24 of one acre, being in Section 8, Township 34 South of Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
