CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, that onegon state agricultural college

of Corvallis , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Oak Creek a tributary of Marys River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 7943 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 28, 1927

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 second foot of water

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWL NWL, Section 33, Township 11 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13.0 acres in SEE NW4, Section 33
3.0 acres in SW4 NW4, "
14.5 acres in NE4 SW4, "
1.5 acres in NW4 SW4, "
33.0 acres in SE4 SE4, "
27.0 acres in NW4 SE4, "
32.0 acres in NW4 SE4, "
18.0 acres in SW4 SW4, Section 34
8.0 acres in NW4 SW4, "
Township 11 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
