## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MRS. JOHN S. BYRNE

of Route 2, Box 62 - Jacksonville, , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Palmer Creek

atributary of Big Applegate, tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation and domestic use for one lamily, being 0.09 c.f.s. for irrigation and under Permit No. 17667 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 7, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NE_+^1$  SE $_+^1$ , Section 7, Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $4\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7 acres in SNA NAA
Domestic in NWA SWA
All in Section 8
Township 40 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: All that part of  $S_2^{\lambda}$  of the NW, and the N½ of the SW $_2^{\lambda}$ , Sec. 8, T. 40 S., R. 3 W., W. M. in Jackson County, Oregon lying westerly of the Applegate River and Northerly of the center line of Palmer Creek.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
