CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ESTRID ROSLINGTON

of Box 373, Aransas Pass, State of Texas, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18163 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 10, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.012 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.95 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 636 feet East of the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon; and thence South 265 feet, more or less, to the center of Evans Creek, and is also Damons Southwest Corner thence South 49 degrees 25' West, along center of Evans Creek, 274.8 ft.; thence North 443.77 feet to the center of the County Road; thence East, along the County Road, 208.71 feet to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom the East 11.16 feet.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
