CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That TRAIL CREEK LUMBER COMPANY

of P. O. Box 806, Medford, , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Trail Creek, Paradise Creek and spring, being 0.22 cfs from West Fork Trail Creek, 0.20 cfs from Paradise Creek and 0.09 cfs from spring, for the purpose of a tributary of Rogue River log pond, fire protection, cooling saws and domestic, under Permit No. 19187 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.51 cubic foot per second, being 0.22 cfs from West Fork Trail Creek, 0.20 cfs from Paradise Creek and 0.09 cfs from spring,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the

Paradise Creek NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 33 South, Range 2 West, W. M.
West Fork Trail Creek NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, W. M.
Spring NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

pond to float logs, fire protection, domestic and water to cool saws in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: The entire N $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19 and S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, all in Jackson County, Oregon

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
