**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** H. J. KIMSEY

of Route 1, Box 496, Ashland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Toleman Creek a tributary of Neal Creek, a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of irrigation, under Permit No. 19698 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 10, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1/3 acre irrigation in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the Southerly side line of Crowson Road, from which point the Northwest corner of Donation Land Claim #54, in Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon, bears North, 21.31 feet and West, 1482.73 feet distant; thence along the Southerly side line of Crowson Road, South 49° 55' West, 103.62 feet to the true point of beginning; thence along said side line, South 49° 55' West, 255.34 feet; thence South 40° 05' East 71.0 feet to the center line of Tolman Creek; thence along said center line, North 85° 24' East, 131.54 feet and North 47° 51' East, 148.30 feet; thence North 40° 05' West, 142.00 feet to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
