CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. F. HEIDENREICH

of State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dedrick Slough a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 16282 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 26, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL NEL, as projected on Jacob Gillespie DLC No. 70, in Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.1 acres in NE NE , Section 30, as projected on Jacob Gillespie D. L. C. #70 9.9 acres in NW NEA, Section 30, as projected on Jacob Gillespie D. L. C. #70 All in Township 17 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the east line of the Jacob Gillespie Donation Lane Claim No. 70, Notif. No. 3243 in township 17 S. R. 3 West of Willamette Meridian at the initial point of the Flat of Debrick Gardens as recorded in book 4 page 101 Lane County Oregon Plat Records, which according to said plat is 28.09 chains north 00° 15' east from the most southerly southeast corner of the claim and running thence west 8.28 chains to a stone 12 x 8 x 2 inches above ground, thence south 20° west 16.13 chains to a point south 81° 36' east 4.81 chains from a point south 00° 06' east 72 links from the corner at the reentrant angle on the south boundary of the Jacob Gillespie Donation Land Claim No. 70, thence south 50° 20' east 3.54 chains, thence south 89° 05' east 3.11 chains; thence north 72° 20' east 8.30 chains to the east line of the claim, thence north 00° 15' east 14.94 chains to the place of beginning, in Lane County, Oregon."

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
