**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** COOS COUNTRY CLUB

of P. O. Box 897, Coos Bay, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two unnamed streams a tributary of Isthmus Inlet for the purpose of supplemental irrigation and domestic, being 0.30 cfs for supplemental irrigation and 0.03 cfs for domestic, under Permit No. 16693, of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 25, Township 26 South, Range 13 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.8 acres supplemental and domestic in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
14.2 acres supplemental in SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>  
All in Section 25  
T. 26 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: North half of the Northwest quarter and Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter, all in Section 25 Township 26 South of Range 13 West, Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon.

Beginning at the intersection of the Westerly line of the Coos City-Summer County Road with the Section line common to Sections 24 and 25, Township 26 South, Range 13 West Will. Mer., thence West along said Section line a distance of 520.00 feet to an iron pipe, marking the Section corner common to Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26, said township and range; thence North 52° 00' East a distance of 203.00 feet to a point; thence East a distance of 190.00 feet to a point; thence North 45° 00' East a distance of 116 feet to a point in the Westerly line of said Coos City-Summer County Road; thence Southerly along said Westerly line of said County Road, in all of its various courses and curves, to the point of beginning, and containing an area of 1.36 acres more or less.

Beginning at the Section corners common to Sections 23, 24, 25, and 26 Township 26 South, Range 13 West of Will. Mer., Coos County, Oregon; thence North 75° 40' West for a distance of 645.9 feet; thence South 3° 15' West for a distance of 140 feet; thence South 3° 48' West for a distance of 276 feet; thence North 86° 18' East for a distance of 74.6 feet; thence North 87° 07' East for a distance of 281 feet; thence South 73° 36' East for a distance of 311.5 feet to a point on the Section line between Sections 25 and 26; thence North along the Section line for a distance of 324.6 feet to the place of beginning. All in Coos County, Oregon.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
