CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Norman McKeel

of Azalea, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Cow Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation of 36.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Douglas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 11, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from September 30, 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed the rate of one cubic foot of water per second of time for each 70 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
11.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12,
T. 32 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

NOTE: This certificate of water right confirms a change in place of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 28, 1949, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-506, O. C. L. A., and supercedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to F. A. Farnam and recorded at page 9622, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
