**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** VAN K. LAWSON

of Route 1, Box 210 - McMinnville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Yamhill River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation, under Permit No. 13893 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 27, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.27 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on John Monroe D.L.C. No. 74, Section 12, T. 5 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.1 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on John Monroe D.L.C. No. 74  
9.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on John Monroe D.L.C. No. 74  
11.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on John Monroe D.L.C. No. 74  
Section 12  
T. 5 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point marked by an iron pipe at the N.W. corner of the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the John Monroe D.L.C.  
Thence S. 2° 33' 06" W. 323.40' along the West line of the John Monroe D.L.C. to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe.  
Thence S. 87° 58' 11" E. 264.0.33' along the line common with the J. R. and Mary Ashford property to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe.  
Thence N. 2° 25' 46" E. 322.40' along the line common with the J. R. and Mary Ashford property to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe on the dividing line between the N. and S. halves of the John Monroe D.L.C.  
Thence N. 87° 58' 11" W. 264.00' along said dividing line of the John Monroe D.L.C. to a point marked by a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe.  
Thence N. 01° 47' 21" E. 1076.99' along the line common with the property of the Federal Land Bank of Spokane to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe.  
Thence N. 88° 13' 48" W. 2361.43' along the line common with the properties of R. K. Plowman and C. Ranshaw, Oregon Credit Agency, The Federal Land Bank of Spokane, and G. W. Jones to a point marked by a 3/4" iron pipe on the West line of the John Monroe D.L.C.  
Thence S. 02° 33' 06" West 1066.31' along the West line of the John Monroe D.L.C. to the point of beginning.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
