CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES L. LATHROP

of Williams, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Williams Creek a tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17159 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 17, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

13 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
25 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the South line of Section 4 in Township 39 South Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian 6 rods East of the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of said section; thence running North and parallel with the center line of said Section about 130 rods to the center of the channel of the West Fork of Williams Creek; thence running Westerly along the center of the channel of the West Fork of Williams Creek to the West line of Section 4; thence South on said Section line to the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section, thence East 166 rods to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
