CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALVIA W. PETERS

of R.F.D. - North Powder, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Van Patton Lake Reservoir a tributary of _____ for the purpose of supplemental irrigation and irrigation under Permit No. 17268 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 26, 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre irrigated during the irrigation season, measured at the head of the ditch that conveys the stored water from North Powder River to the land to be irrigated, from Van Patton Lake Reservoir covered by certificate recorded on page 8477 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion ~~is located in the~~ from Van Patton Lake is located in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 16, T. 7 S., R. 37 E., W. M. and from North Powder in Sec. 32, T. 6 S., R. 38 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre, this appropriation shall be limited to 4.0 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season for each acre irrigated subject to the terms and conditions of deed by Chris and L. M. Johnson dated August 15, 1946 conveying interest in reservoir to permittees, and provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
