CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARBOR PLYWOOD CORP. OF OREGON

of Hoquiam, State of Washington, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Cow Creek, tributary of Umpqua River, to be appropriated under Application No. 25112, Permit No. 19760,

for the purposes of log pond, manufacturing, boiler plant and fire protection

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1069 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 9, 1950

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-said, shall not exceed 119.4 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 23, NE 1/4, NW 1/4, & SW 1/4, SW 1/4, SW 1/4 & Tp. 30 S., R. 6 W., W.M. SE 1/4, SE 1/4
