**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** HARBOR PLYWOOD CORPORATION OF OREGON

of Hoquiam, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of log pond and boilers, being 0.44 cfs for pond and 0.01 cfs for boilers under Permit No. 15855 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 3, 1944.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, as projected on James Catching D.L.C. #43, Section 26, T. 30 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~xxx x xxx~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Beginning at a  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch square headed bolt on the South right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railway, 30 feet out at right angles from the center line, said beginning point being 2826.3 feet South and 92.4 feet, or 1.4 chains East of the NW corner of the Isaac A. Flint D.L.C. No. 45, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, W. M. Thence along the southerly side of said Railroad right-of-way North 59° 04' East 332.0 feet; thence along a fence line South 10° 45' east 1000 feet; thence West 471.0 feet; thence North 808.7 feet to the place of beginning, containing 8 acres. (All in Section 23, T. 30 S., R. 6 W. W. M.)

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
