# CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ALEX FRANCE

of Fall Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Big Fall Creek a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17362 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 22, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Frederick Waren D.L.C. #43, Section 33, T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.25 c.f.s.,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 1.7 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Frederick Waren D.L.C. #43
- 4.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Frederick Waren D.L.C. #43
- Section 32
- 3.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Frederick Waren D.L.C. #43
- 0.9 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Frederick Waren D.L.C. #43
- Section 33
- T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of the west half of Donation Land Claim No. 43 in Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 1 West, of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence North 71 $\frac{1}{2}$  rods, thence east 69 rods; thence south 43 rods; thence west 10 rods; thence south 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  rods and thence west to the place of beginning, containing 29 acres, more or less, of land, lying in Sections 32 and 33 in said Township and Range and in Lane County, State of Oregon; excepting therefrom the property described in that certain deed dated April 6th, 1944 and recorded in Book 265 at pages 301-2, Lane County Oregon Deed Records, Lane County, Oregon; and which exception is more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the southeast corner of the west half of Donation Land Claim No. 43 in Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 1 West W. M., in Lane County, Oregon; thence running north 683 feet, thence east 90 feet, thence south 683 feet, thence west 90 feet, to place of beginning, all in Lane County, Oregon.
