CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GUS KAUFMANN

of Route 2, Box 246 - Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation, under Permit No. 17495 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 6, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.15 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Abram Landers D.L.C. #54, Section 28, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Abram Landess D.L.C. #54
10.2 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Abram Landess D.L.C. #54
1.7 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Abram Landess D.L.C. #54
Section 28
T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Lying and being in Section Twenty-eight (28), Township one (1) South, Range Two (2) West of the Willamette Meridian and bounded by beginning in the center of the County Road, running from Hillsboro to Farmington, at the Northwest corner of the land owned by Wm. J. Ingram, August 6, 1891, and known as a part of the A. Landess D.L.C., running thence West on the North line from the center of said road 20 rods; thence Southwesterly parallel with the center of said road 20 rods; thence East 20 rods to the center of said road, and thence along the center of said road 20 rods to the place of beginning, containing 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land;

Also

Lying and being in the Abram Landess, Jr. D.L.C. in Township one (1) South, Range Two (2) West of the Willamette Meridian and particularly described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said claim and running thence East along the North line of said D.L.C. 23 chains to the Northwest corner of the certain 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre tract heretofore conveyed by William Ingram and wife to I. B. Everson and Jennie Everson, deed for which is recorded at page 88 of Book 32 of the Records of Deeds of Washington County, Oregon, and running thence Southwest along the West line of said 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre tract, 5 chains to the southwest corner thereof; thence due West 23 chains, more or less to the center of the Tualatin River; thence up the center of said river 5 chains more or less to the Northwest corner of said Landes Donation Land Claim, to place of beginning, 12 acres more or less in said County and State.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
