CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EOFF BROS.

of Route 4, Sherwood, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Chicken Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 11969 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1935

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.15 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW SW & SE NW Section 20, as projected in James Canfield D. L. C. #41, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 11.6 acres in NE¼ SE¼, as projected in James Canfield D.L.C. 41
 - 4.0 acres in SE¼ SE¼, as projected in James Canfield D.L.C. 41 Section 19
 - 1.1 acres in SW¼ NW¼, as projected in James Canfield D.L.C. 41
 - 20.6 acres in SE¼ NW¼, as projected in James Canfield D.L.C. 41
 - 30.2 acres in NW¼ SW¼, as projected in James Canfield D.L.C. 41
 - 18.0 acres in NE¼ SW¼, as projected in James Canfield D.L.C. 41 Section 20
- T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
