atributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 15694 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 9, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $^{\rm NW}$ SW4, Section 16, T. 1 N. 4. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Being a part of Sections 16 and 17, T. 1 N.R. 3 W. Will. Mer., to-wit: Beginning at a stone set at angular corner on the north boundary line of a tract of 14.85 acres heretofore conveyed to B. H. Marsh, said stone being 14.95 chains north and 2.79 chains west of the southeast corner of said Section 17, running thence North 0°20' West 14.65 chains to the center of Dairy Creek; thence down the center of said creek, with the meanderings thereof, to the northeast corner of said tract of land heretofore conveyed to B.H.Marsh, thence South 89°40' West 14 chains to the place of beginning, and containing 36.50 acres, more or less, as described in Deed Book The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
