## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

## This Is to Certify, That Addie Marsh

of Route 1 - Cornelius , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dairy Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigation for the purpose of

under Permit No. 15069 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 26, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.52 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE2NH, NE2SH2, Section 21, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together will the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightisth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in SM2 MEL, as projected on Michael Wren D.L.C. No. 54
4.1 acres in Lot 2 (SW2 MEL)
16.2 acres in NEL NW2
38.0 acres in SE4 NW4
36.6 acres in NEL SW2
15.1 acres in Lot 5 (SE2 SW2)
4.4 acres in Lot 3 (NW2 SE2)
1.2 acres in NM2 SE2, as projected on Michael Wren D.L.C. #54
2.7 acres in Lot 4 (SW2 SE2)
0.8 acres in SW2 SE2, as projected on Michael Wren D.L.C. #54

T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows:

That portion of the John Marsh homestead in Section 21, TIN,R3W. being the land inherited by John I. Marsh from his father, G. W. Marsh, in Probate Estate No. 1745, Washington County, Oregon, and containing 113.25 acres, more or less. ALSO:

Commencing at the southeast corner of the D.L.C. of John Marsh and wife in TIN, R3W. Will. Mer., and running thence North on East line of said Marsh claim 7 chains, thence Northeast 4 chains across to the East bank of Dairy Creek; thence up the East side of Dairy Creek to a point directly east of the intersection of the thread of said Dairy Creek with the West line of the D.L.C. of Michael Wren and wife in said township and range; thence west to center of said creek, thence up center of said creek following the meanderings thereof to the center of the County Brige over said creek in the Centerville-Forest Grove Road; thence south 13° 30' West 7.75 chains to the Northwest corner of school house lot, thence South 51°=ast 3.50 chains, thence South 39° West 2.86 chains, thence North 51° West 3.50 chains, thence South 12.74 chains to a post in County Road, thence East in center of County Road 8.15 chains to place of beginning, containing 16.20 acres, more or less. ALSO:

Beginning at a point in the public road leading from the town of Centerville to Forest Grove near the West end of the Centerville Bridge and running thence S. 39° W. 2.86 chains to a post, thence S. 51° Jast 3.50 chains to a post, thence N. 39° E. 2.86 chains to a post, thence N. 52° West 3.50 chains to the place of beginning and containing 1 Acre more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use hercin described.
