CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Bernard J. Van Grunsven

of Route 2 - Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15700 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 21, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.7 acres in SW SW, Section 16
17.3 acres in SE SE, Section 17
T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Beginning at the corner of Sections 16, 17, 20, and 21 in said Township and Range, running thence West 20.50 chains to an iron on the East line of the Charles Conklin DLC No. 53, thence North 0 deg. 10' East on said East Line of Claim No. 53, 9.85 chains to beginning point of right of way conveyed by J. S. Jackson to J. W. Marsh; thence North 89 deg. 56' East 17.71 chains to an iron; thence North 0 deg. 21' West 5.05 chains to a stone at the Southwest corner of a tract of land heretofore conveyed by grantee to the widow and children of William W. Marsh, deceased, thence North 89 deg. 40' East 14 chains to center of Dairy Creek, thence down the center of Dairy Creek with the meanderings thereof, to the South line of Section 16, thence North 89 deg. 48' West 19.40 chains to place of beginning, containing 44.85 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
