CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Neil D. Currie

of Route 1, Box 316 - Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Palmer Creek a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16365 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 7, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.295 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW SW, Section 31, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

21.4 acres in SW SW
2.2 acres in Lot 4 (NW SW)
Section 31, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Donation Land Claim of James McKinley and wife, Notification #2210 in Township 5 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Yamhill County, State of Oregon; thence West 54.65 chains; thence North 21.67 chains to the South line of the Donation Land Claim of Joseph Kirkwood and wife; thence running East along South line of said Donation Land Claim of Joseph Kirkwood and wife, to the Southeast corner thereof; thence continuing East 84 rods to the Northeast corner of land known as Nathaniel Crosiar Land; thence running South 87.51 rods to the South line of the Donation Land Claim of James McKinley and wife, above named; thence running West along the South line of said Donation Land Claim of James McKinley and wife to the place of beginning, and containing 189.15 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
