## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

## This Is to Certify, That Clarence Van Dyke

of Route 2 - Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. 15621 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 6, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.375 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NE_{\tau}^{L}$ ,  $SE_{\tau}^{L}$ , as projected in Chas. Conklin D.L.C. No. 53, Section 18, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

17.3 acres in NEA SEA, as projected in Chas. Conklin D.L.C. No. 53 8.2 acres in NWA SEA, as projected in Chas. Conklin D.L.C. No. 53 4.5 acres in SEA, as projected in Chas. Conklin D.L.C. No. 53 Section 18, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Commencing at the NW corner of the Henry Vander Zanden's land in Sec. 17, 18, 19 & 20 Township 1 N., Range 3 West, Willamette Mer., as described on pages 254 to 256 in Book "O", Records & Deeds for Wash. County, Ore. and running thence east on the north line of my land 3.91 chains; thence south 30 links, thence west 2.87 chains, thence south 2.00 chains; thence south 54 degrees west 1.18 chains to a post on the west line of said land; thence north down the middle channel of Dairy Creek 3.00 chains to the place of beginning, containing 37/100 acres of land, more or less.
Beginning at the NZ corner of the West one-half of the DLC donation land claim of Charles

Conklin and wife in Sec. 18, Township 1 N., R. 3 W., Willamette Mer., and running thence South 25.17 chains to a post; thence West 15.18 chains to a post; thence North 14.00 chains to the center of Driry Creek with all its Heanderings to the North line of said Conklin Claim, thence East 31.30 chains to the place of beginning, containing 55.18 acres, more or less.

Excepting, however, the following tract, to wit: Beginning at the NE corner of the West one-half of the D.L.C. of Charles Conklin in section 18, Township 1 N., Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, thence South 1.51 chains, more or less, to the center of Dairy Creek, thence M. westerly up said stream to a point where said stream intersects the North line of said Conklin D.L.C., thence east on North line of said claim to the place of beginning, containing 1 acre, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
