## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALBERT J. EVERS

of Route 2, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Dairy Creek a tributary of Dairy Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17570 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 25, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.415 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Chas. Conklin D.L.C. #53, Section 18, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 20.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Chas. Conklin DLC #53  
1.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Chas. Conklin DLC #53  
Section 17  
0.5 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Chas. Conklin DLC #53  
3<sup>2</sup> 10.5 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected in Chas. Conklin DLC #53  
Section 20, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Commencing at a post on the south boundary line of the Charles Conklin and wife Donation Land Claim in Section 17, 18, 19 and 20 in T1N., R3W, in the County of Washington, State of Oregon 9.21 chains east of the division corner between said Charles Conklin and his wife. Thence north in the County road twenty four chains and 56 $\frac{1}{2}$  links; thence east sixteen chains and 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  links; thence south twenty four chains and 56 $\frac{1}{2}$  links to a post on said south boundary line; thence west on said south line 16.28 $\frac{1}{2}$  chains to the place of beginning, containing 40 acres, excepting therefrom that tract of land heretofore sold to O.J. Seghers, Arch Bishop for Cemetery Site, the deed for which is recorded in Book Q page 448 of the records of Washington County, Oregon, also 20 feet for road way leading from said Cemetery to the public highway.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
