CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARRY CROME

of RR #3 - McMinnville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Yamhill River a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17684 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34 & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, as projected in Jacob Hampton D.L.C. #71, Township 5 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 5.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Hampton D.L.C. #71
 - 10.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Hampton D.L.C. #71
 - 14.4 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Hampton D.L.C. #71
- Section 34, T. 5 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Begin at a point 43.676 chains East of the Northwest corner of Section Thirty four Township Five (5) South, Range Five (5) West of the Willamette Meridian, said point being the Northeast corner of that certain 139.17 acre tract of land deeded by Manuel O. Edwards and wife to Martha Sargent and John W. Gant, April 17th 1908 thence running East 10.194 chains, thence South 15°20' East 40.92 chains; thence South 61° East 24.69 chains; thence South 56° West 14.12 chains; thence West 20.92 chains to the Southeast corner of said 139.17 acre tract above referred to, on the South line of the Jacob Hampton Donation Land Claim; thence North 59.50 chains to the place of beginning, containing one hundredth thirty (130) acres, more or less;

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
