CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CARL E. PEIRSON

of Route 2, Box 16 - Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 18489 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 14, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.314 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.3 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 1.0 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 17.3 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 0.1 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 7 T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.
 0.8 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 2.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 12
 T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: Lots 1,2,3,4 & 5, Rich Acres beginning at a point on the South Bank of Tualatin River where Jacksons Bridge crosses the same and running thence east with the meanderings of said river 3 rods; thence 118 rods; thence west 7 rods to the County Road leading from Hillsboro to Laurel and known as the Jackson bottom Road, thence North with and along said road 120 rods to the place of beginning, being in Section 12, T. 1 S 3 W., W. M. Ex. Lot #5 Rich Acres. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
