**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** B. KARLSON

of Route 2, Box 165 - Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18663 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 25, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.403 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 9, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.7 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Arthur Burriss D.L.C. #42  
Section 4

14.2 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Arthur Burriss D.L.C. #42  
11.1 acres in Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )

0.2 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Arthur Burriss D.L.C. #42

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows:  
Parcel No. 1: Beginning at a point 20 chains East of the center of Section Eight, Township Two South, Range Two West of the Willamette Meridian; thence North 20 chains; thence East 15 chains; thence South 20 chains; thence West 15 chains to the place of beginning.

Parcel No. II: Beginning at a point 20 chains North and 40 chains East of the center of Section Eight, Township Two South, Range Two West of the Willamette Meridian, thence East 40 chains; thence North 20 chains to the section line between Section Four and Nine, in Township Two South, Range Two West of the Willamette Meridian; thence East 2 chains, more or less to the center line of the Tualatin River; thence in a Northwesterly direction along the center of said river, 18 chains; thence South 47°23' West 39.41 chains to the center of the drainage ditch; thence Southwesterly in the center of said ditch to the point of beginning, subject to the covenants in that certain deed dated August 11, 1904, recorded October 3, 1904 in Book 66 of Deeds at page 187, and subject to the terms of that certain decree entered in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for Washington County, in the case of Len W. Guild v R. A. Wallis, et al.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
