CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED SCHELLER

of Aloha Dairy, Route 3 - Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18583 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.04 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Wooley D.L.C. No. 49, Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

19.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Wooley D.L.C. #49
5.1 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Wooley D.L.C. #49
NESW → 8.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Wooley D.L.C. #49
3.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Wooley D.L.C. #49
30.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Wooley D.L.C. #49
16.7 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected in Jacob Wooley D.L.C. #49
Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: "Beginning at a point on the South line of the Jacob Wooley Donation Land Claim No. 49, in T. 1 N, R. 3 W. W. M., 39.67 chains North 88 42' West from the Southeast corner of said Claim; thence North 1 30' East 44.93 chains; thence North 88 40' West 36 links; thence North 1 30' East 18 links to the center of road No. 344; thence North 88 40' West 20.45 chains to a point in said road No. 344; thence S. 25 W. 45.18 chains to the S. line of the D.L.C. aforesaid 19.88 1/2 chains E. of the SW corner of said claim; thence S. 88 1/2' E. 19.97 chs. to pt. of beg. cont. 92.03 a. ±, sit. in Wash. Co., Ore. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
