CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That T. G. CONGILL
of $\frac{1}{2}$ Linn County Abstract Office
of Albany, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
unnamed creek
a tributary of South Santiam River for the purpose of
irrigation
under Permit No. 18698 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 15, 1949 for 0.38 c.f.s. & May 3, 1949 for 0.045 c.f.s. ;
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.425 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Andrew Kees D.L.C. #69,
Section 35, T. 11 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

- 9.9 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Andrew Kees Cl. #69
- 9.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Andrew Kees Cl. #69
Section 35, T. 11 S., R. 2 W., W. M.
- 9.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Andrew Kees Cl. #71
- 5.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Andrew Kees Cl. #71
Section 2, T. 12 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows:
Beg. 50.84 chs. E. of the S.W. corner of the D.L.C. of M. J. Kees Claim 69, Tp. 11 S.
R. 2 W. thence E. 90 rods to the center of the main channel of the creek, thence down
the cen. of said creek to a point 12.40 chs. E. of a point 26.97 chs. N. to beg.
thence W. 12.40 chs. thence S. 26.97 chs. to beg. cont. 50 acres, Sec. 2 Tp. 12 R. 2 W.
Beg. 40 rods E. of the N. E. cor. of D.L.C. 38 in Tp. 12 2 W. thence E. to a point 1.75
chs. W. & 9.50 chs. S. of N. E. cor. of Sec. 2, thence S. 20°W. 21.50 chs. to N. line
of claim 44, thence W. 15 chs. thence N. 20 chs. to beg. contg. 40 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
