CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L.F. BETNIKER

of Route 2, Box 252, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19234 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 3, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.52 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 21, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 2.2 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected on Henry Norland D.L.C. #67
25.6 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected on Henry Norland D.L.C. #67
4.4 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected on Henry Norland D.L.C. #67
9.4 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected on Henry Norland D.L.C. #67
Section 21, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. 11.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: That portion of the William Ingram and wife D.L.C. and the Henry Roland and wife D.L.C No. 67 lying within section 21 T 1 S. R 2 W. W.11. described as follows: Beginning at a point in said section 21 from which the E 1/4 corner thereof bears N 22° - 0' E 15.77 chains and E. 12 chains; thence S20°-15' E 32 links; thence S32°-0' W to a point in the dividing line between the north and south halves of said In ran D.L.C. 25.21 chains W of the E line thereof; thence W on said dividing line 34.79 chains to the W line of said claim; thence N on said W line to the intersection of the right bank of the Tualatin River; thence E 2 rods to the center of said river; thence up the center of said river to a point 1.75 chains W of the point of beginning; thence E 1.75 chains to said point of beginning; the right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
