that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.013 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the \mathbb{N}^{-1}_{+} , Sei, Section 12, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., N. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be fur her limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.75 core in SM, NE4, as projected on James Hicklens D.L.C. #43 0.25 acre in NA2 SEA, as projected on James Hicklens D.L.C. #43 Section 12, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows: All of Lot 17 of Fanno Creek Acre tracts, a duly recorded subdivision in Washington County, Oregon, as conveyed to S. E. Lovett by deed as recorded on page 503 of volume 289 of Washington County, Oregon deed records.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
