CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. C. ROBINSON

of Adel, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Burnt Creek a tributary of Deep Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14664 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 28, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.93 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 5, T. 40 S., R. 22 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated prior to June 15, and 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated after June 15, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from March 1, to October 1, of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

33 acres in NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄
9 acres in SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄
15 acres in SE¹/₄ SE¹/₄
Section 5
15 acres in NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄
5 acres in NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄
Section 8
T. 40 S., R. 22 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
