CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARRY D. ESPERSON

of Route 2, Box 630, North Bend, Oregon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of Coos Bay for the purpose of domestic and irrigation, being 0.01 cfs for domestic and 0.0015 cfs for irrigation under Permit No. 17116 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 26, 1915,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.0115 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.125 acre and domestic in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2
T. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T. 25 S., R. 13 W. of W.M., from which point the iron pipe at the section corner on the N. boundary of the said Section 2 bears N. 41°32 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W. a distance of 1990.41 feet; and also from which point the SE corner of Block 15 of the plat of Townsite of Glasgow, Coos County, Oregon, according to the map and plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk of the said County, as the same existed prior to the vacations on the said Townsite of Glasgow as made in 1936, bears N. 26°36 $\frac{3}{4}$ ' W. a distance of 133.94 feet;- and running thence East for a distance of 600.00 feet; thence S. for a distance of 340.25 feet; thence W. for a distance of 300.0 feet; thence S. for a distance of 100.0 feet; thence W. for a distance of 300.0 feet; thence N. for a distance of 440.25 feet to the place of beginning, but subject to the right of way easement for a County Road right of way 60 feet in width which crosses the above described tract in a northerly and southerly direction. Containing 4.97 acres, more or less, exclusive of the County Road right of way, and being a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T. 25 S., R. 13 W. of W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
