**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That HANS SELFORS**

of Route 1, - North Bend, State of Oregon, has made pr j  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
an unnamed spring  
a tributary of Coos Bay for the purpose of  
domestic and irrigation, being 0.01 cfs for domestic and 0.0015 cfs for irrigation  
under Permit No. 17116 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from June 26, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.0115 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, T. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one - eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to  
a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during  
the irrigation season of each year,

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

0.125 acre and domestic in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2  
T. 25 S., R. 13 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows:  
Beginning at the NW corner of Block 12 of the plat of Townsite of Glasgow, Coos  
County, Oregon, according to the map and plat thereof on file and of record in the  
office of the County Clerk of the said County, as the same existed prior to the street  
vacations made during 1936; the said point being 1440 feet S and 50 feet E. of the  
section corner on the N. boundary of Section 2, T. 25 S., R. 13 W. of W. M. - and running  
thence E. along the S boundary of Avenue A in the said Townsite of Glasgow for a distance  
of 1270 feet to a point on the E boundary of the said Townsite of Glasgow; thence S.  
along the said E. boundary of the vacated Sixteenth Street in the said Townsite of  
Glasgow for a distance of 465.0 feet, more or less, to a point on the westerly boundary  
of the Glasgow-Kwntuck Slough County Road; thence Southwesterly along the said County  
Road boundary for a distance of 410 feet, more or less, to a point on the center line  
of a certain un-named street lying between Blocks 1 and 2 of the said Townsite of  
Glasgow; thence W. along the center line of the said street for a distance of 195 feet,  
more or less, to a point on the center line of Fifteenth Street in the said Townsite  
of Glasgow; thence S. along the said center line of Fifteenth St. for a distance of 40.0  
feet; thence W. for a distance of 407.0 feet; thence N. 43°W. for a distance of 335.0  
feet; thence N. 71°W. for a distance of 107.5 feet to a point on the south boundary  
of Oregon Avenue in the said Townsite of Glasgow as the same existed prior to the street  
vacations made in 1936; thence N. along the said S. boundary of Oregon Ave. in the  
Townsite of Glasgow for a distance of 207.89 feet; thence N., parallel to and 25.0 feet  
E. of the center line of Central Avenue in the said Townsite of Glasgow for a distance  
of 330.0 feet to a point on the S. boundary of the un-vacated portion of Michigan Ave. in  
the said Townsite of Glasgow; thence East along the said boundary of the un-vacated  
portion of Michigan Avenue for a distance of 325.0 feet to the East end of the said un-  
vacated portion of Michigan Avenue; thence North for a distance of 50.0 feet to the North  
boundary of the said un-vacated portion of Michigan Avenue; thence W. along the N. boundary  
of the said un-vacated portion of Michigan Avenue for a distance of 275.0 feet to the

southeast corner of Lot 1 of Block 12 of the said Townsite of Glasgow; thence North for a distance of 100.0 feet to the northeast corner of the said Lot 1 of Block 12; thence W. for a distance of 50.0 feet to the northwest corner of the said Lot 1 of Block 12 as existing subsequent to the street vacations made during 1936; thence North, parallel to and 25.0 feet east of the center line of Central Avenue in the said Townsite of Glasgow for a distance of 100.0 feet to a point on the S. boundary of Avenue A in the said Townsite of Glasgow; thence E. for a distance of 25.0 feet to the point of beginning.

Being Lots 2 to 12 inclusive and Lots 21 to 32 inclusive, in Block 12 of the Townsite of Glasgow, Coos County, Oregon, all of vacated Block 2 of the said Townsite of Glasgow lying W. of the Glasgow-Kentuch Slough County Road; all of vacated Blocks 3, 4, 5, 13 and 14 of the said Townsite of Glasgow; vacated Lots 13 to 20 inclusive of Block 12 of the said Townsite of Glasgow, and vacated portions of F Fourteenth Street, Fifteenth Street, Sixteenth Street, Michigan Avenue, Oregon Avenue and an un-named street lying between Blocks 1 and 2 in the said Townsite of Glasgow, as vacated during 1936 and additional vacations made during 1940, also a portion of Lot 3 of Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 13 West of Willamette Meridian lying outside of the Townsite of Glasgow and a portion of the tide lands fronting and abutting upon the said Lot 3 of Section 2.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
