CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RUSSELL E. & RUTH E. O'CORNOR

of R. R. 1, Box 286, Banks , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

West Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River

for the purpose c;

irrication under Permit No. 10789 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.048 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4 & NE4 SE4, Section 5, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: Beg. at a point 170 ft. N of the center line of Sec. 5, T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W. M. in the center of Dairy Cr., and 80 rods W of the E line of said Sec. 5, and running thence in a southeasterly direction up the center of said Dairy Creek, 186 ft., thence in a northwesterly direction up the center of said Dairy Creek 112 feet; Chence in a northwesterly direction 185 ft. to the parallel line running north from the place of beg., thence S on said line 151 ft. to the place of beginning. Also the SW No. 10 Section 5, T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W. M., save and except therefrom the following described property, to wit: Being part of the SW No. 10 Sec. 5, T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W. M., beginning at an iron bar set at the center of said Sec. 5, and running on the half section line N. 1º 45' E. 19.67 chains, the NW cor. of said SW No. 10.80 chs. to a post; thence S. 3° 45' east 9.35 chs., thence S. 14° 3' W. 10.80 chs. to a point on the south line of said NE of Section 5, thence on said S. line N. 89° 32' W. 10.80 chs. to the place of beg., excepting also two tracts conveyed to the State of Oregon by and through its State Highway Commission as recorded in book 181, page 73 and book 176, page 641, deed records of Washington Co., Oregon fror 27 Jan., 1943.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
