CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE H. BEELER

of Route 1, Gaston , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of Willamotic River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17005 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 14, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.337 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of a version is located in the $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}$, as projected on D. McLeod D.L.C. No. 49, and Lot 5, $(NV_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}}SE_{\frac{1}{4}}^{\frac{1}{4}})$, Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ene—eightheth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

17.4 acres in NE SE, as projected on D. McLeod D.L.C. No. 49
1.8 acres in NW SE, as projected on D. McLeod D.L.C. No. 49
7.6 acres in Lot 5 (NW SE)

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

N. of the center line of the Tualatin R., thence S. 85° 3h! E. 1270.1 ft. to an iron pipe on the E. line of the B. S. Jones farm; thence S. 2° 30' E. 762.75 ft. to an iron pipe on said east line which was set as a reference point at safe distance from river wash; thence continuing S. 2° 30' E. 36.2 ft. to the center line of the Tualatin R., thence S. 84° 40' W. 392.0 ft. to a meander point on the river center line; thence on the center line meander courses N. 51° 55' W. 286.0 ft., thence N. 77° 10' W. 118.9 ft., thence N. 53° 16' W. 102.0 feet; thence S. 82° 36' W. 106.4, ft., thence N. 57° 6'W. 250.4 feet; thence S. 84° 45' W. 145.0 ft. to a point on the intersection of the Don McLeod east line and the center line of the Tualatin R., thence N. 2° 30' W. 38.4 ft. to an iron pipe; thence continuing N. 2° 30' W. 521.6 ft. to the point of beginning, enclosing 21 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
