CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WASHINGTON COUNTY

of Court House, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Jackson Creek a tributary of McKay Creek for the purpose of rock crushing, cooling and washing rock under Permit No. 17796 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 14, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 2 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 33
Township 2 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Book 100, Page 105, Washington County, Oregon, Deed Records, in Sec. 33, T. 2 N., R. 2 W., W. M., Washington County Oregon.

Beg. at the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. on the N. line of said Section 33, and running thence E. on said N. line, 660 feet; thence S. 39° 48' W. 1031 feet, more or less, to the W. line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 33; thence on said W. line, N. 792 ft. to the place of beg., containing 6 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
