CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under reservoir permits)

This is to Certify, That J. L. WRIGHT

of Perdue, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of St. Johns Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River

for the purpose of the irrigation of lands described in Permit No. 1836, certificate of water right recorded in Volume 3, at Page 1971, State Record of Water Right Certificates

under Reservoir Permit No. 260 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 280, on the 9th day of March, 1918; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 3, 1913

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 20 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 27, Tp. 30 S., R. 3 W., W. M.
