CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That REIDE W. LOCKMAN & R. A. HOLMES

of R. F. D. 1, Box 52 A, Sherwood, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River and an unnamed drainage ditch a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17994 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 24, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second, being 0.083 c.f.s. from River and 0.287 c.f.s. from drainage ditch,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the , Tualatin River: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; drainage ditch: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
23.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 24
Township 2 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beg. at point on the E. line Sec. 24, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 20 chs. N. of the SE cor. of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 24, running thence N. along the E. line of said Sec; 20 chs. to the NE corner of the DIC of William J. and Mary J. Barr. Thence W. along the N. line of said Barr DIC 6 chs., thence S. on a line parallel with the E. line of said Sec. 20 chs. to the N. line of S $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec. 24. Thence E. along said last line 6 chs. to the place of beginning containing 12 acres of land more or less. ALSO: The easterly portion of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 24, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Commencing at the SE cor. of said N $\frac{1}{2}$ of S $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec. 24; running thence northerly parallel with the easterly boundary of said section 80 rods; thence westerly parallel with the southerly boundary of said section 52 rods; thence running southerly parallel with said easterly boundary line of said section 80 rods; thence running easterly parallel with the southerly boundary line of the said section to the place of beginning comprising about 26 acres excepting tract described in Deed Book 152, page 330 subject to roads, driveways, and easements as the same now exist or appear.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
