CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CARL OLSON

of Box 122, Cherry Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of

a log pond under Permit No. 18078 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 5, 1947 for 0.02 c.f.s. and December 16, 1947 for 0.12 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 c.f.s.

Land or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on T. B. Speaks D.L.C. No. 51, Section 27, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beginning at a stone on the N. line of the T. B. Speaks DLC #51, in Sec. 22, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.; Washington County, Oregon, at the NW cor. of the east half of said Speaks DLC., running thence along the N. line of said Speaks DLC, S. 88°59' E. 1467.7 ft.; thence S. 18° 02' E. 1685.8 ft. to a point in the center of Scoggins Valley Road 30 ft. S. 18° 02' E. of a stone; thence along said Scoggins Valley Road S. 67° 17' W. 98.0 feet; thence S. 57° 47' W. 277.9 feet; thence N. 80° 25' W. 321.0 feet; thence N. 89° 53' W. 688.1 feet; thence S. 67° 45' W. 709.4 ft. to the west line of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Speaks DLC; thence N. 2062.3 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
