CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARLEY TAYLOR

of Route 2, Box 191, Cornelius , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 18138 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 28, 1948 for 1.25 c.f.s. and March 30, 1948 for 0.135 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.385 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $\mathbb{N}_{\frac{1}{4}}$ $\mathbb{N}_{\frac{1}{4}}$ and $\mathbb{N}_{\frac{1}{4}}$ $\mathbb{N}_{\frac{1}{4}}$ as projected on C. Enerick D.L.C. No. 48, Section 9, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to one—eightlieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; when in the distribution of water it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices, the applicant or his successor in interest will be required to install these so as not to restrict the natural channel of the stream or interfore with the flow of the water therein. The location and plans of these structures shall be approved by the State Engineer prior to construction,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
