CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. LE ROY MILLS

of Route 3, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of McKay Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15693 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 9, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 2 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 24
Township 2 North, Range 3 West, W. M.
12.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
Township 2 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beginning at an Iron on the Range line between Sec. 19, T. 2N, R. 2W, W.M., and Sec. 24, T. 2N., R. 3W, W. M., which iron bears S0° 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W. 454.0 ft. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. between said sections; thence from the described point of beginning N 89° 16' E. 1297.0 feet to an iron on the westerly edge of the County Road; thence continuing N. 89° 16' E. 22.0 ft. to a point on the E line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T. 2 N., R. 2 W., W. M., which point bears S0° 2 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W 453.2 ft. from a stone at NE corner of the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence S. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W. on the said E line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ a distance of 432.2 ft. to an iron; thence S. 89° 14' W. 1318.0 ft. to an iron on the line between Section 19, T. 2N., R. 2 W., W. M., and section 24, T. 2N., R. 3W., W. M., which iron bears S0° 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W. 887.0 ft. from the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. between said sections; thence S 88° 46' W. 1297.4 ft. to an iron on the West line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 24, T. 2N., R. 3W., W. M., thence N. 0° 28' E. In said West line 433.0 ft. to an iron which bears S0° 28' W. 454.0 ft. from an iron at the recognized NW cor. of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 24; thence N. 88° 46' E. 1295.8 ft. to the place of beg., containing 25.99 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
