CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. T. HABERMAN

of Selma , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek

a tributary of Deer Creek to Illinois River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 15746 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 10, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEA SWA, Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state cfficer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre in NEA SWA
1.3 acres in SEA SWA
Section 2
Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W. H.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

The North one half of the Southwest one quarter of Section 2 in Township 38 South Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon containing 80 acres, less and excepting a parcel of land conveyed to W. C. Moore described as follows: Deginning at the center of said Section 2 and running thence West 75 feet; thence South 100 feet; thence East 75 feet; thence North 100 feet to the place of beginning Excepting the right of way of the Redwood Highway, as the same is now located.

Also the South one half of the Southwest one quarter of said Section 2, less and excepting a certain parcel of land described as follows: Beginning 400 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Southwest one quarter of said Section 2 and running thence North 920 feet; thence West 144 feet to the center line of the Redwood Highway thence Southerly along said center line to a point that is 200 feet West of the place of beginning; thence East 200 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
