**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify,** That WILSON A. AND CORRINE V. ETTINGER

of Route 2, Box 303, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18290 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 16, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Chas. Stewart D.L.C. No. 56, Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.375 c.f.s. When in the distribution of water it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices, the applicant or his successor in interest will be required to install these so as not to restrict the natural channel of the stream or interfere with the flow of the water therein. The location and plans of these structures shall be approved by ~~the State Engineer prior to construction.~~ ~~the proper state officer.~~

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.2 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Charles Stewart D.L.C. No. 56

- 8.6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Charles Stewart D.L.C. No. 56
- 0.2 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Charles Stewart D.L.C. No. 56

- 3.8 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Charles Stewart D.L.C. No. 56

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: Commencing at the SW Cor. of said Charley Stewart and wife DIC and running S 69° E 2975 chs. thence N 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 4779 chs. N 57° W 11.50 chs., S 69° W 17.80 chs. more or less to W line of Charles Stewart & wife DIC S. 1° E. following the W. line of said DIC, 36.50 chs. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
