CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That S. ROY MATTESON

of Gaston, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Scoggins Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of developing 6.82 theoretical horsepower, not electrical under Permit No. 16717 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 30, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected on Ransom M. Hawkins D.L.C. No. 55, Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Power in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected on Ransom M. Hawkins D.L.C. No. 55 Section 18

Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of the south half of R. M. Hawkins D.L.C. No. 55 T. 1 S., R. 4 W., Will. Mer., Washington County, Oregon, running thence South along the west line of said Hawkins D.L.C. 34.32 chains to the southwest corner of said D.L.C. a point in the center of Sain Creek; thence down the center of said creek with the meanderings thereof in an Easterly direction 40.00 chains more or less to the center of county road No. 281; thence north 48 deg. 30' east 10.68 chains; thence north 41 deg. 45' east 8.96 chains; thence north 18 deg. 30' west 9.46 chains to the north line of S. E. Wilcox D.L.C. thence west 7.48 chains thence south 1.25 chains to the division line between the north and south halves of said Hawkins D.L.C. thence west 47.06 chains to the place of beginning, containing 137 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
