## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That FRED GESCHWILL

, has made proof State of Oregon of Route 2, Woodburn to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pudding River

a tributary of Molalla River

for the purpose of

irrigation of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 17014 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 22, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.40 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4, (SW SW SW ), Section 21, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 13.2 acres in Lot 1 ( $NE_4^1$  SE $_4^1$  SE $_4^1$  SE $_4^2$  acres in Lot 2 ( $NV_4^1$  SE $_4^1$  SV $_2^2$ ) 9.8 acres in Lot 4 ( $10^{14}_{4}$  SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  17.8 acres in Lot 5 (SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ 31.8 acres in Lot 8 (SE4 SE4 Section 20 (NW 3 SW 3 5.4 acres in Lot 3 18.8 acres in Lot 4 (SW4 SW4) Section 21

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: Beg. at the SE cor. of the DIC of Alexander W. Sweeney and Angeline Sweeney his wife, Cert. No. 7659, Claim No. 48, in Marion Co., Ore., being parts of sections 19, 20, and 21 in T. 5 S., R. 1 W., thence W. 104 chs. and 32 links to the E. boundary line of the first described parcel of land mentioned in that certain deed from David M. Hall and Lucy Hall, his wife, to Samuel Brown, recorded in Marion County Records, Book 3 of Deeds, Page 330, thence N. 25 chs. and 90 links, more or less to the N. boundary line of the said DIC., thence E. on said N. boundary line of said DIC 11 chs. and 78 links; thence S. on said N. boundary line of said DIC 87° E. 77 chs. and 57 links; thence E. 14 chs. and 73 links, more or less, to the E. boundary line of said claim; thence S. 22 chs. and 25 links, more or less, to the place of beg., containing 249.63 acres of land more or less.
