CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DARREL F. PETERSON

of Route 3, Box 710, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Cedar Mill Creek, tributary of Beaverton Creek, to be appropriated under Application No. 22098, Permit No. 17528,

for the purposes of irrigation and fish culture,

under Reservoir Permit No. R-865 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1946,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 34, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, T $\frac{1}{2}$ North, R1 West, W. M.
