CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DARREL F. PETERSON

of Route 3, Box 710, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cedar Mill Creek, Unnamed Creek, and Cedar Mill Pond constructed under Permit No. R-365 a tributary of Beaverton Creek for the purpose of fish culture and supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 17528 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second, being 0.20 c.f.s. for fish culture and 0.02 c.f.s. for supplemental irrigation,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.5 acres fish culture and supplemental irrigation in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Township 1 North, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center of the Cornell County Road, which point is the Southwest corner of a certain tract or parcel of 16.75 acres of land conveyed by Ruby L. Arshambeau to Hattie C. Arshambeau by deed recorded May 31, 1928, in Book 138 at Page 551, Deed Records of Washington County, Oregon; running thence North along the West line of said tract, which West line is also the East line of the McDaniel Road, 340 feet to an iron pipe; thence East 370 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 347 feet to a one inch iron pipe in the North line of the Cornell County Road; thence South 30 feet to the center line of the said Cornell County Road; thence Westerly along the center of the Cornell County Road 375 feet to the point of beginning, containing 3.11 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
