CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. WALTER SUHRBIER

of Route 1, Box 44, Gaston, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17504 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 11, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.279 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{8}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
3.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
17.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 33

Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ section cor. on the S. line of Sec. 33, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W.M. thence N. 0° 31' E. 16.70 chs. to the center of the Tualatin R., thence down the center of said river to the W. line of a tract of 100 acres formerly conveyed to B. F. Purdy by J. T. Gerrish; thence S. on such W. line 18.44 chs., more or less to a stone on the S. line of Section 33, distant 15.00 chains from the southeast cor. of said Section 33; thence N. 89° 51' W. 25 chs. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
