CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ARCHIE B. CULNICK

of Star Route, Gales Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Eiler Creek, a tributary of Gales Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17618 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 19, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 1.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
- 4.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
- Section 7
- 2.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 2.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
- Section 8

Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: Being a part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W.M. Beginning at a point on the W. line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W.M., said beginning point being N. 1°04' W. 1033.86 ft. from the center of said Sec. 7, and running thence along said west line of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7, N. 1°04' W. 470.56 ft. to an iron; thence S. 89° 20' E. 3283.2 ft. to a point in the center of County Road #30; (from which an iron pipe bears N. 89° 20' W. 30 feet) thence along the center of said road S. 0° 34' W. 470.56 ft. to a point from which an I. P. bears N. 89° 20' W. 30 ft.; thence N. 89° 20' W. 3269.2 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 35.385 acres. EXCEPTING, however, tracts as more particularly described in Deed Book 203, Page 327 and Deed Book 195, page 691, records, of Washington County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
