**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That R. M. JONES**

of **Route 1, Forest Grove**, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring tributary of **Dairy Creek** for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation under Permit No. **18116** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **January 16, 1948**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.074 cubic foot per second,**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected on Benjamin Catching D.J.C. No. **41**, Section **25**, Township **1 North**, Range **4 West**, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ **one-eighth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **0.07 c.f.s.,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**0.25 acre and domestic in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 25**

**Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W. M.**

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows: The following described real estate, situated in Washington Co., Ore., being in part of the DIC of Benjamin H. Catching and wife in T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W.M., to wit: Commencing at a point in the center of the County Road leading northerly from Forest Grove, Oregon, to Thatcher, Oregon, said beginning point being N. 14° 40' E. 3.64 chs. and S. 89° 40' E. 23.23 chs. from the NE cor. of the Union Cemetery Association grounds, in Sections 26 and 35, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W.M., running thence in center of said road N. 3° 35' W. 3.98 chs. to a point 1.33 chs. N. of the division line of said Benjamin H. Catching DIC, thence S. 89° E. 14.83 chs., thence S. 3° 35' E. 9.08 chs., thence N. 89° 40' W. 13.78 chs. to a point in the center of said County Road, thence in center of said road N. 40° 45' W. 1.98 chs., thence N. 3° 35' W. 3.74 chs. to the place of beginning, containing **13.09 acres, more or less.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
